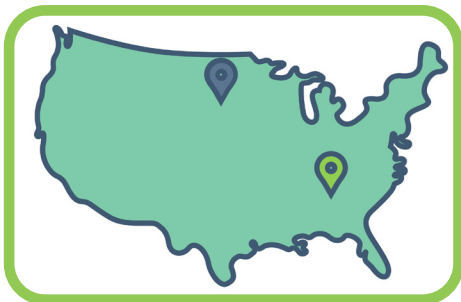
Missions Funding Distribution

1,197 MILES

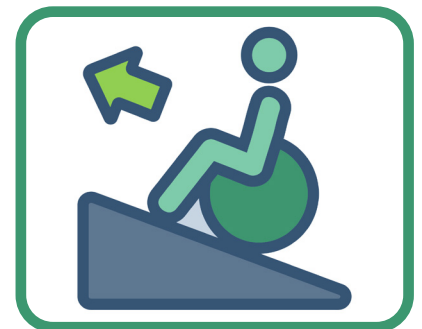
Distance traveled to **PINE RIDGE, SOUTH DAKOTA** to love our indigenous neighbors in the poorest county in America.
